Caution

Thompson's Meadow is separated from the Forest River Conservation Area by very busy railroad tracks. It is both illegal and dangerous to cross these tracks! There are two parallel tracks on this main North Shore route, and the sound of a train coming from one direction can conceal the sound of a train coming from the other. Curves also limit the visibility of oncoming trains. **DO NOT attempt to cross the tracks**
